

CODE REVIEWS TO BEGIN MICHIGAN ELECTRICAL CODE

The Bureau of Construction Codes is accepting public comments and proposed code changes for the Code Advisory Committee review phase of the 2008 Michigan Electrical Code.

Review of the code has begun.

The following information **must** be included within your submitted proposal.

REQUIRED INFORMATION:

1. Indicate the rule or table your proposal affects.
2. Provide the name of the local government, organization, or individual proposing the code change.
3. Provide the name, address, telephone number, fax number and email address of the contact person to supply information, as needed, on the proposed changes.
4. The specific rule for which an amendment is proposed should be listed. The **entire rule** should be reproduced, including the proposed amendatory language.
5. All added words should be **in bold type**.
6. All deleted words should be struck through and underlined. (example)
7. If more than one page is necessary, include your name and rule number on each additional page.
8. Thoroughly explain the need and reason for the proposed change including any anticipated benefits, and economic cost or savings realized by the proposed change, as well as any other information appropriate to assist the Bureau and committee in a clear understanding of the issue. During the rulemaking process, the Bureau must defend the need and reasonableness of all proposed rule changes; therefore, a detailed explanation is necessary to ensure the committee thoroughly considers all aspects of the proposal.
